

Homework Timetable

Topic

Parents and children receive a letter each half term informing them about the upcoming topic and suggesting ideas for their Home School Project. Every child is expected to submit at least one piece of work for every topic. The deadline is the Friday of the penultimate week of each half term.

Reading

All children and parents are encouraged to read together at least three times each week. Rewards are given weekly to those children who do so.

Spellings

All children and parents are encouraged to spend time at home each week learning sounds/spellings. In Key Stage Two these are usually sent home on a Friday. Children are tested on these spellings the following Friday. In Key Stage One they are sent out at the beginning of each half term and there is a spelling test every Friday.

Mathletics

Children have their own Username and Password for this online resource. They are encouraged to access it at home as much as possible.

Key Stage 2

Literacy and Maths homework

All children in Key Stage 2 are given weekly maths and literacy homework. This is in line with what they have been taught and therefore helps to consolidate their understanding and their ability to apply their knowledge and skills independently.

In Year 3/4, the homework is given out on a Friday and must be returned by the following Friday.

In Year 5/6, the homework is given out on a Friday and must be returned by the following Thursday.

If children do not complete their homework at home, they are asked to do so at play/lunch time.

A homework club is available for Year 3/4 children on a Wednesday dinnertime and for Year 5/6 children it is after school on a Tuesday.
