Dear Parents,

As part of our Science Topic about plants, the children in Year 3 have the opportunity to bring their learning to life with a visit to Harlow Carr.

The visit will take place on Thursday, 7th June. We will leave school at 9.00am and return at approximately 3.15pm. The children will need to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle for the day. The children are also required to wear school uniform.

The children will be expected to arrive at school at 8.30am where they will immediately get on the coach. This is due to the need to arrive at Harlow Carr by 10.00am.

The actual cost of the trip is £10.50 per child. Unfortunately, if parents are unable to contribute this amount for their child we will not be able to organise the visit. There is no longer any entitlement to funds from the Local Authority to help parents on low incomes to contribute towards visits, but any parent who has difficulty making the contribution should contact school to discuss an alternative arrangement.
