SCHOOL UNIFORM

If you are intending to buy school uniform during the Summer holidays, please remember the school's requirements:

- Black or dark grey: Trousers, skirts, pinafores, culottes, formal shorts.
- White: Juniors—formal shirt, Infants—polo shirt
- Royal blue: V-necked jumper or cardigan.
- Blue and white checked dress in summer.
- Track suit tops, hoodies, etc. are not allowed to be worn as part of the uniform.
- Black indoor pumps (Year 3-6). Slippers are no longer acceptable.
- For PE and Games, children wear plain black shorts and black t-shirt, trainers for outdoor PE.

All clothing, including shoes and pumps, should be clearly marked with your child's full name please. All uniform should be readily available at most outlets, including Better and Bright in Castleford Market.

The School Office sells ties (for Junior children) at £2.40. School book bags embroidered with the school logo are also available at £3.60. School badges (to sew on jumpers/cardigans) are available for £2.00.

ATTENDANCE AND TERM-TIME HOLIDAYS

A big thankyou to all children who have 95% attendance or more. Many congratulations to the 43 children who have achieved 100% attendance so far this year!

Can I remind parents that I am not allowed to authorise term-time holidays. If parents take children on holiday without permission during term time, it has to be recorded as an unauthorised absence and this may result in a penalty notice.

If your child is ill and will not be attending school, please telephone the office on 01977 524483 to notify them of your child's absence. If you know of hospital or dental appointments, please bring the letter into school to show the class teacher.

All absences of five or more days in total must be supported by medical evidence. These do not need to be consecutive. Absences of five or more days without medical evidence will not be authorised and as such may be subject to a Penalty Notice from the Local Authority.

Supportive medical evidence can be in the form of the following:

- a copy of the prescription with the name of the child and the date
- Medication with a chemists label showing the name and the date
- An "unfit for School" declaration or letter from your GP in the case of
- A hospital discharge letter

If you cannot supply any of the above, the absence may be registered as "unauthorised".
