## BREAKFAST CLUB

The school are now offering a Breakfast Club to all children in full time school. This takes place every morning in the school Dining Hall. Children are welcome from 7.45am and are given a tasty breakfast before being escorted to the school to begin their day. Children can make their own choices for breakfast with a wide range of food options available including cereals, toast with a choice of hot and cold toppings and sausage sandwiches available on Fridays. The children can then take part in a range of free choice activities such as board games, Lego, colouring in etc. The fee for this club is £3.50 per child, per day. For Free School Meals children the club is free.

We have registered for Tax Free Childcare to help with the costs for breakfast club. A letter was sent to all parents in February however, if you require further information please see the School Office.

## ATTENDANCE AND TERM-TIME HOLIDAYS

**A big thank you to all children who have 97% attendance or more. Many congratulations to the 29 children who have achieved 100% attendance so far this year!**

Can I remind parents that I am not allowed to authorise term-time holidays. If parents take children on holiday without permission during term time, it has to be recorded as an unauthorised absence and this may result in a penalty notice issued by Wakefield Metropolitan District Council—monies to be paid to the Educational Welfare Service. All other Primary Schools in the Castleford pyramid have this recommendation in place.

If you know of hospital or dental appointments, please bring the letter into school to show the class teacher. Please confirm the illness in writing via a note or completing a school form.
